

SEASONAL LAWN CARE

STEPS TO MAKE SURE YOUR LAWN IS THE
ENVY OF THE ENTIRE NEIGHBORHOOD

LATE MARCH - EARLY MAY

Apply granular crab grass prevention
product and fertilizer



EARLY MAY

Rake or de-thatch lawn

MID - LATE MAY

Apply granular weed and feed



EARLY - MID JUNE

Spray lawn with liquid weed killer (if
needed) i.e. Tri-Mec, Ban Vil, 2-4D

JULY & AUGUST

Follow up with liquid weed killer
(if needed) and check for lawn pests
(i.e. Chinch bugs, sod webworm,
Japanese beetle grub). Apply pesticide
if needed (Diazinon, Dursban). Also
check for lawn disease (i.e. powdery
mildew, rust brown, patch, etc.) and
apply fungicide if needed (each
diseases should be identified and
treated specifically).



LATE AUGUST - EARLY SEPTEMBER

Apply weed and feed of Turf
builder. Granular fertilizer.

MID - LATE SEPTEMBER

De-thatch or Core Aerate
(if not done in spring).

MID - LATE OCTOBER

Apply Granular Winterizer Fertilizer
(your lawn should have a good start
for next spring).
Also, carve your Jack-o-Lantern.
